Q: What are the best materials (i.e., paper, cardstock, vinyl, iron-on, etc.) to use with Cricut machines and can I use products other than those produced by Cricut?
A: Cricut machines have been designed to cut a wide range of materials with incredible accuracy. You'll get great results with paper, cardstock, vinyl, iron-on, and so much more. Many pressure settings in the software are specifically engineered to support materials produced by Cricut. You can also cut materials from other brands; however, you may need to adjust pressure settings to get the best results. Pre-programmed settings for Cricut Explore and Cricut Maker machines are listed on help.cricut.com.

Q: Do I have to have a computer to use Cricut machines?
A: All Cricut Explore and Cricut Maker machines require you to connect to our cloud-based software, Design Space. Design Space is available for Windows and Mac computers as well as iOS and Android mobile devices.

Cricut Explore and Cricut Maker machines have recommended minimum system requirements for use. View the full system requirements on help.cricut.com.

Q: How often do you need to change blades?
A: This depends on the materials being cut as well as the frequency. As with all cutting tools, the life of the blade depends on what you are cutting and the pressure you're using when cutting. Hard or dense materials will wear a blade more quickly than soft, flexible materials.

They handle a wide variety of popular crafting materials, including paper, cardstock, vinyl, iron-on, faux leather, fabric, and more! All Cricut machines come with Design Space®, our free, easy-to-learn design software, featuring thousands of images, ready-to-make projects, and fonts for inspiration. Or you can upload your own images and fonts for FREE. Whether you start your designs from scratch or get a head start with existing images, Design Space lets you edit and personalise your project with ease. Once you've got a design you love, place your material on a mat, load it into the machine, and press Go. The machine cuts, writes, and scores, and you get to do all the fun parts – assembling, sewing, and adding finishing touches to your masterpiece.

Q: Is it a printer?

A: No, Cricut smart cutting machines can cut, score, or use pens to write on your materials. They do not contain ink cartridges. However, Design Space for Cricut Maker and Cricut Explore machines has a Print Then Cut feature. Create your design in Design Space, send it to your home printer to print, then load it into your Cricut Explore or Cricut Maker machine and watch it cut with precision!

Q: Can I upload my own images with Cricut?

A: Yes. Design Space gives you the ability to upload most .jpg, .png, .bmp, .gif, .svg, and .dxf files for free. Refer to help.cricut.com for the latest specifications to upload your own images.

Q: What kinds of projects can I make with Cricut machines?

A: With the ability to handle a wide variety of materials and the versatility of Design Space software, you can accomplish a myriad of DIY projects, from scrapbooks, greeting cards, and planners, to home organization and decor, to personalised bags, clothing, fashion accessories, kids' crafts, and more! Q: What tools and accessories do I need and how much do they cost?

A: This will depend entirely on your individual use of Cricut machines. At the very least, we recommend the Basic Tool Set, spare cutting mats with different grip strengths, and extra blades. For vinyl and iron-on projects, we recommend the Weeding Tool Set and Cricut BrightPad™. For paper crafts, we recommend Scoring Wheel tools (for Cricut Maker) or Scoring Stylus (for Cricut Explore family machines).

For cutting thicker materials with Cricut Explore family machines, we recommend the Deep-Point Blade + Housing. For Cricut Maker, we recommend Knife Blade + Drive Housing for thicker, denser materials, including balsa wood, chipboard, and leather.

Q: How do I find information and get advice on how to use the machine and tips on the best way to make projects?
