MATERIALS

To Fit	Female Adult Hand	
Finished Length approx	23 9	cm ins
Gallipoli DK/8ply (100gr)	1	Ball
Gallipoli 4ply Print (100gr)	1	Ball
Needle sizes	4ply: 3.25mm (US 3) straight needles DK/8ply: 4mm (US 6) straight needles 2 buttons

ABBREVIATIONS

Beg - beginning
cm - centimetres
cont - continue
ins - inches
k - knit
meas - measures
NR - next row
p - purl
rep - repeat
RS(F) - right side (facing)
st(s) - stitch(es)
Stst - stocking stitch (= k on RS rows, p on WS rows)
WS - wrong side

IMPORTANT

Use ONLY the Naturally yarn specified. (We cannot accept responsibility for an imperfect item if any other brand is used.)

TENSION

4ply: 28 sts and 36 rows over Stst - 10cm (4ins) on 3.25mm (US 3) needles.

DK/8ply: 22 sts and 30 rows over Stst - 10cm (4ins) on 4mm (US 6) needles

CHECK YOUR TENSION CAREFULLY

DK/8ply FINGERLESS GLOVES

Note: Finished Gloves will be approx ¼ shorter once cable has been created

FIRST HAND

With 4mm (US 6) needles, cast on 66 sts.

Rows 1, 3, 5 & 7 (RS) - P16, k40, p10.

Rows 2, 4, 6 & 8 (WS) - P all sts.

Row 9 (RS) - P16, cast off 20 sts, with 1 st already on needle, k further 19 sts, p10.

Row 10 (WS) - P30, cast on 20 sts (turn if you have to for cast on), p16.

Rep these 10 rows 5 times more.

Rep rows 1-8 once.

[Now is the point to measure if the 20 sts Stocking Stitch section fits around your **upper hand** (excluding thumb); if it is not enough, then work rows 9 & 10 and then rows 1-8 once more].

Cast off loosely all sts.

COMPLETE

Join the lower 16 purl sts for cuff, secure end, break off yarn.

Skip the 20 sts cast-off section; join the upper Stst section until 19 sts rem in total, secure end, break off yarn.

Skip 6 or 7 sts for thumb (check if it fits), join rem sts, secure end, break of yarn.

Twist first 20 sts section into loop, then slip 2nd section through

loop, then 3rd section and so on to end; tack upper centre of last loop to bottom of first; sew large button to bottom of first section and slip loop over for closure.

OPTIONAL: If you desire the "cable" to face the other direction, work as above but twist the last 20 sts section into loop, then slip 2nd last through loop, then 3rd last and so on.

4ply FINGERLESS GLOVES

Note: Finished Gloves will be approx ¼ shorter once cable has been created

FIRST HAND

With 3.25mm (US 3) needles, cast on 84 sts.

Rows 1, 3, 5, 7 & 9 (RS) - P20, k51, p13.

Rows 2, 4, 6, 8 & 10 (WS) - P all sts.

Row 11 (RS) - P20, cast off 25 sts, with 1 st already on needle, k further 25 sts, p13.

Row 12 (WS) - P39, cast on 25 sts (turn if you have to for cast on), p20.

Rep these 12 rows 5 times more.

Rep rows 1-10 once.

[Now is the point to measure if the 20 sts Stocking Stitch section fits around your **upper hand** (excluding thumb); if it is not

enough, then work rows 11 & 12 and then rows 1-10 once more]. Cast off loosely all sts.

COMPLETE

Join the lower 20 purl sts for cuff, secure end, break off yarn.

Skip the 25 sts cast-off section; join the upper Stst section until 24 sts rem in total, secure end, break off yarn.

Skip 7 or 8 sts for thumb (check if it fits), join rem sts, secure

end, break off yarn.

Twist first 25 sts section into loop, then slip 2nd section through loop, then 3rd section and so on to end; tack upper centre of last loop to bottom of first; sew large button to bottom of first section and slip loop over for closure.

OPTIONAL: If you desire the "cable" to face the other direction, work as above but twist the last 25 sts section into loop, then slip

2nd last through loop, then 3rd last and so on.
