MATERIALS		
<b>HAT</b>	To fit Medium Adult size head	
<b>Lammermoor Organic DK/8ply</b>		
<b>#87 (A)</b>	1	Ball
<b>#88 (B)</b>	1	Ball
<b>Needle size</b>	3.75mm & 4mm (US 5 & 6) straight needles Spare needle to hold pocket lining and flap 2 buttons	

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ABBREVIATIONS
<b>cm</b> - centimetres
<b>cont</b> - continue
<b>ins</b> - inches
<b>k</b> - knit
<b>meas</b> - measures
<b>mm</b> - millimetres
<b>NR</b> - next row
<b>p</b> - purl
<b>rem</b> - remaining
<b>rep</b> - repeat
<b>RS</b> - right side

## TENSION

22 sts and 30 rows over Stst - 10cm (4ins) on 4mm (US 6) needles.

### CHECK YOUR TENSION CAREFULLY

## POCKET LINING

With 4mm (US 6) needles and B, cast on 23 sts.

Stst for 23 rows (yes, end with a RS row). Break yarn, leaving longer end for sewing.

Leave lining on spare needle.

## BUTTONHOLE FLAP

With 3.75mm (US 5) needles and A, cast on 23 sts.

**Row 1 (RS)** - K1; \*p1, k1; rep from \* to end.

**Row 2** - K1; \*p1, k1; rep from \* to end.

Moss stitch as established 2 more rows.

**NR (RS)** - Buttonhole row - Patt 3, k2tog, yo twice, skp, patt 9, k2tog, yo twice, skp, patt 3.

Moss stitch 7 more rows straight.

Break yarn, leaving longer end for sewing.

Leave flap on spare needle.

## HAT

Using 3.75mm (US 5) needles and A, cast on 115 sts.

**Row 1 (RS)** - \*P1, k3, p1; rep from \* to end.

**Row 2** - \*K1, p3, k1; rep from \* to end.

Rep last 2 rows 7 times more.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles. Stst 4 rows.

Using B, Stst 4 rows.

Using A, Stst 6 rows.

Using B, Stst 6 rows.

Using A, Stst 2 rows.

**NR (RS)** - Using A, k74; p1, [k1, p1] 10 times; k20.

**NR** - Using A, p20; k1, [p1, k1] 10 times; p74.

**NR (RS)** - Using A, k74; cast off next 21 sts, k to end.

**NR (WS)** - insert pocket lining - Using A, p19, (with WS facing of hat and pocket lining) purl together last st before opening with first st of pocket lining, p21 across pocket lining, purl together last st of pocket lining with next st of hat; purl to end of row.

**NR (RS)** - attach buttonhole flap - Using A, k73 (with RS of flap in front of hat) knit together first st of flap with next st of hat, cont to knit together one stitch of flap with one stitch of hat until all flap sts are used up (flap now covers one stitch before opening, across opening including one stitch after opening); k rem 19 sts.

**NR (WS)** - Using A, purl.

Using B, Stst 8 rows.

Using A, Stst 6 rows.

Using B, Stst 2 rows.

### Shape Top

**NR (RS)** - Using B, k9, skp, k1, k2tog; [k18, skp, k1, k2tog] 4 times; k9 - 105 sts.

**NR** - Using B, purl.

**NR (RS)** - Using B, k8, skp, k1, k2tog; [k16, skp, k1, k2tog] 4 times; k8 - 95 sts.

**NR** - Using B, purl.

**NR (RS)** - Using B, k7, skp, k1, k2tog; [k14, skp, k1, k2tog] 4 times; k7 - 85 sts.

**NR** - Using B, purl.

**NR (RS)** - Using B, k6, skp, k1,

k2tog; [k12, skp, k1, k2tog] 4 times; k6 - 75 sts.

**NR** - Using B, purl.

**NR (RS)** - Using B, k5, skp, k1, k2tog; [k10, skp, k1, k2tog] 4 times; k5 - 65 sts.

**NR** - Using B, purl.

**NR (RS)** - Using A, k4, skp, k1, k2tog; [k8, skp, k1, k2tog] 4 times; k4 - 55 sts.

**NR** - Using A, purl.

**NR (RS)** - Using A, k3, skp, k1, k2tog; [k6, skp, k1, k2tog] 4 times; k3 - 45 sts.

**NR** - Using A, purl.

**NR (RS)** - Using A, k2, skp, k1, k2tog; [k4, skp, k1, k2tog] 4 times; k2 - 35 sts.

**NR** - Using A, purl.

**NR (RS)** - Using B, k1, skp, k1, k2tog; [k2, skp, k1, k2tog] 4 times; k1 - 25 sts.

**NR** - Using B, purl.

**NR (RS)** - Using B, k2tog across, end row with k1 - 13 sts.

**NR** - Using B, purl.

Break yarn, leaving longer end, thread end through rem sts, pull tight, secure end.

Neatly sew pocket lining in place. Join back seam. Sew in ends.

Sew on buttons.
