# BERNAT PET CROCHET PET BED

## **i** INTERMEDIATE

### WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- Bernat® Blanket Pet™ 225g:  
Navy (34022) 5 balls
- 6 mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain correct tension
- Long sewing needle.
- Thread.
- 2 large buttons.
- 91.5 cm square pillow

### ABBREVIATIONS

**Approx** = Approximately, **Beg** = Begin(ning),  
**Ch** = Chain(s), **Tr** = Treble,  
**Inc** = Increase(ing), **Rep** = Repeat,  
**Rnd(s)** = Round(s), **Dc** = Double crochet,  
**Sl st** = Slip stitch, **Sp** = Space(s),  
**St(s)** = Stitch(es), **Tog** = Together,  
**WS** = Wrong side

### MEASUREMENT

91.5 cm square

### TENSION

10 dc and 10 rows to 10cm using 6mm  
crochet hook

### INSTRUCTIONS

#### FRONT AND BACK (make alike)

**Note** – After 1st rnd, join all rnds with sl st to 3rd ch of beg ch-5. Ch 4. Join with sl st to first ch to form ring.

**1st round** – Ch 3 (counts as tr). 15 tr in ring. Join. 16 tr.

**2nd round** – Ch 5 (counts as 1 tr and ch-2 throughout). 2 tr in same sp as last sl st. 1 tr in each of next 3 tr. \*(2 tr. Ch 2. 2 tr) in next tr. 1 tr in each of next 3 tr. Rep from \* around. 1 tr in first ch-2 sp. Join.

**3rd round** – Sl st in first ch-2 sp. Ch 5. 2 tr in same sp as last sl st. 1 tr in each tr to next

ch-2 sp. \*(2 tr. Ch 2. 2 tr) in next ch-2 sp. 1 tr in each tr to next ch-2 sp. Rep from \* around. 1 tr in first ch-2 sp. Join.

Rep 3rd rnd, inc 16 sts per rnd, until work measures approx 91.5 cm. Fasten off.

### JOIN

With WS tog, join yarn with sl st to any corner ch-2 sp. Working through both thicknesses, join edges with 1 rnd of dc, inserting pillow before joining last edge. Join with sl st to first dc.

**Next round** – Ch 1. Working from left to right instead of right to left as usual, 1 reverse dc in each dc around. Join with sl st to first dc.

**Buttons** – Measure and mark center of Pillow. Thread a long, sharp sewing needle and pierce through center of Pillow. Cinch tightly. Sew one button to top and bottom of Pillow at center.
