# CROCHET DAISY TOP

## i INTERMEDIATE

### WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- 4 Seasons 'Brighton' 50g: 8 (9,12) balls Yellow (C1), 3(4,6) balls White (C2)
- 4mm hook
- Scissors, yarn needle, stitch makers, tape measure

Finished Garment Measurements				
SIZE		Small (8-10)	Medium (12-14)	Large (16-18)
Width (approx)	cm	98	112	126
Arm Circumference	cm	42	42	47
Ease (positive)	cm	13	17	21
To fit (bust)	cm	85	95	105

**TENSION** - Daisy motif measures 7 x 7 cm

### SPECIAL STITCHES/ ABBREVIATIONS

- ch - chain
- ch-sp - chain space
- dc - double crochet
- tr - treble
- sl st - slip stitch
- st/s - stitch/es
- rep - repeat
- 3tr-cl - 3 treble cluster (see below)
- beg cl - beginning cluster (see below)
- Yo - Yarn over

### INSTRUCTIONS

3tr-cl: Yo, insert your hook in the indicated st, yo and pull up a loop. (Yo, pull through 2 loops on your hook), \*yo, insert hook in same st, yo and pull up a loop, (yo, pull through 2 loops on your hook). Repeat from \*, yo, pull through all 4 loops on your hook.

Beg cl: Ch 2, Yo, insert your hook in the indicated st, yo and pull up a loop. (Yo, pull through 2 loops on your hook), yo, insert hook in same st, yo and pull up a loop, (yo, pull through 2 loops on your hook), yo, pull through all 3 loops on your hook.

### DAISY MOTIF

Make 96 (108, 142) Motifs

With 4mm hook and C1, make a magic ring

**1st Round:** 3ch, 11tr into magic ring, sl st join to 1st st... 12sts

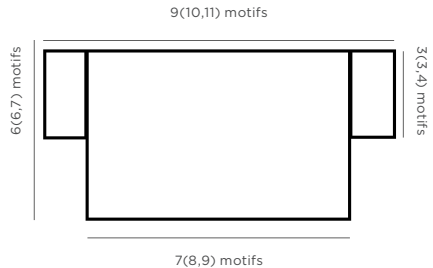
**2nd Round:** With C2, beg cl in next st, ch, \*(3tr-cl, ch) into next st, rep from \*10 times, sl st to 1st st ... 12 3tr-cl, 12 ch.

**3rd Round:** With C1, ch 3 in ch-sp, 2tr in same ch-sp, ch, (3tr, ch) into next ch-sp, \*(3tr, 3ch, 3tr, ch) into next ch-sp, (3tr, ch) into next 2 ch-sps, rep from \* twice, (3tr, 3ch, 3tr, ch) into next ch-sp, sl st to 1st st ... 48tr, 20 ch.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

### TO MAKE UP:

Join your squares with a mattress stitch, or personal preferred



Join front and back sides, on both sides, from arm opening, to base of garment.

Allow a neck opening of 30-35 cm and join shoulder seam on both sides from desired collar edge to top of arm opening.

Trim - All sizes:

Along neckline, sleeve edges and base of garment:

With 4mm hook and C2,

Dc into every st, and ch-2 sp. Sk over every ch-1 sp around, join to 1st st.

For sleeves and base:

Continue with a second row ow dc into each st around

Fasten off and weave in ends.
