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CROCHET WALL HANGING

i INTERMEDIATE

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- 1 ball each of 100 gram '4 Seasons' Marvel 12 ply (4 colours)
- 5.00mm crochet hook
- Scissors, yarn needle
- 50 cm dowel or branch for hanging

FINISHED SIZE

38x38 cms (square only).

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain; **dc** = double crochet;
Rnd = Round; **RS** = right side; **sk** = skip;
sl st = slip stitch; **sp** = space;
st/s = stitch/es; **tr** = treble crochet;
trtr = triple treble crochet;
WS = wrong side.

INSTRUCTIONS

Square – make 4 Main Colour (MC) with Colour 1 (C1), make 8 Main Colour with Colour 2 (C2) and make 4 Main Colour with Colour 3 (C3).

Note – Leave a 30 cm length of yarn (C1, 2 and 3) at the end for sewing up.

Foundation Ch: Using MC, 4ch, join with sl st into 1st ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (RS) – 3ch (counts as 1 tr), (2tr, 2ch, 3tr) in ring, 1 ch, change to C1, 2 or 3, by working 1 ch, (3tr, 2ch, 3tr) in ring, 1 ch, 1 dc in 3rd ch of first chain 3. Turn.

Rnd 2 (WS) – 3ch, 2tr in ch-sp, 1 ch, (3tr, 2 ch, 3tr) in next 2 ch-sp, 1 ch (3tr, 1ch) in next 2 ch-sp, change to MC by working 1 ch, 3tr in same ch-sp, 1 ch, (3tr, 2 ch, 3tr) in next 2 ch-sp, 1 ch 3tr, in next 2 ch-sp, 1 ch, 1 dc in 3rd ch of first chain 3. Turn.

Rnd 3 (RS) – 3ch, 2tr in ch-sp, 1 ch, 3tr in next 1 ch-sp, 1ch, (3tr, 2 ch, 3tr) in next 2 ch-sp, 1 ch 3tr in next 1 ch-sp, 1ch (3tr, 1ch) in next 2 ch-sp, change to C1, 2 or 3, by working 1 ch, 3tr in same ch-sp, 1 ch, 3tr in next 1 ch-sp, 1ch, (3tr, 2 ch, 3tr) in next 2 ch-sp, 1 ch, 3tr in next 1 ch-sp, 1ch, 3tr in next 2 ch-sp, 1 ch, sl st in 3rd ch of first chain 3.

FINISHING

Place motifs as per chart and, working from the right side, sew squares together by using an invisible stitch through the back loops only, of the last round worked.

Border – Draw up a loop in any corner, 1ch, and work 1dc in each st, in back loop only, work 2dc in each corner, ending with an extra dc in st of first dc, sl st in first ch. Bind off, and weave in loose ends. Press to flatten, using cloth and wool setting with steam.

Attach to dowel using a yarn needle and length of MC yarn double yarn. Wrap around dowel and hanging at regular intervals as pictured and continue to end.

Tie – Using MC work a length of ch 100cm long. Bind off and tie on either side of dowel.
