Dory

BEDSIDE BOOK HOLDER

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- Finding Dory fabric - 1 metre of one design (Fabric A) and 40cm of a different design (Fabric B)
- 2.25 metres of orange bias binding
- ½ a metre padded interfacing
- 40cm x 30cm piece of iron on interfacing
- Orange sewing machine thread to match the bias binding

STEP 1

Measure and cut out the following pieces in your Finding Dory fabric: -

4 x pieces (2 in fabric A and 2 in fabric B) 52cm wide by 35cm

2 x 40cm wide by 30cm high piece for the pocket

STEP 2

Iron the padded interfacing onto one of the large pieces

Iron the interfacing onto one of the pocket pieces

STEP 3

With right sides together attach a fabric A piece (the one with padded interfacing) to one of the fabric B pieces and straight stitch them together along the top 52cm edge.

STEP 4

With wrong sides together match the two pocket pieces together and finish the top edge with bias binding.

Overlock or zig zag around the other three seams to join them together.

Centre the pocket onto the padded interfacing fabric piece with the bottoms lined up. Stitch up the two sides of the pocket with the edges folded under so that you are attaching the pocket to the main fabric piece. Don't forget to backstitch at the tops to add strength.

STEP 5

With the last two large fabric pieces place them right sides together and straight stitch them together along the top 52cm edge like before.

STEP 6

Now with wrong sides together lay out the two pieces on top of each other and overlock or zig zag stitch around all 4 sides to attach them all together in one piece, matching seams. You can cut a curve on the bottom two corners so that it will be easier to attach the bias binding.

Attach bias binding to the project starting at the top right hand side and continue to add bias binding around the bottom edge and back up the other side. There is no need to do it on the very top edge as that will be the piece that sits under the mattress to hold the book holder in place.

Press your finished bedside book holder with an iron.
