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# GINGHAM SHOPPING BAG HOLDER



### WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- 1m of Y/D cotton Gingham
- 20cm elastic (4mm width)
- Safety Pin
- Ruler
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Thread
- Sewing Machine

### **CUTTING:**

**Step 1-** This project is made using two simple rectangles.


Using your pencil and using the gingham pattern as a guide to cut straight lines.

Cut two rectangles of fabric. One 45cm X 55cm and one 7cm X 20cm.

### **SCALE: 1/10**

### **SHOPPING BAG HOLDER - HANGING LOOP**



### SEWING:

**Step 1-** Fold over made pattern piece longer sides together and sew with 1cm seam allowance.

### Press seam open.

**Step 2**- At top of main tube double turn a 1cm hem and sew.

**Step 3**- At bottom of main tube double turn a 1cm hem and sew leaving a 2cm gap. This is to thread the elastic through.

**Step 4**- Using the safety pin, feed the length of elastic through the bottom hem.

Secure elastic together at ends on sewing machine.

Step 5- Close hem to hold elastic in.

**Step 6**- With hanging loop pattern piece, sew long ends together and turn right side out creating a tube. Press with seam to back.

**Step 7**- Fold hanging loop in half and secure to inside of top of the holder main.

We used a square and cross stitch for added strength for the loop.
