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## HALLOWEEN QUARTER SQUARE TRIANGLE QUILT

## i INTERMEDIATE

## WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- $12 \times$ " $25 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF" cuts of different Halloween fabrics
- 0.5m Black Prima
$\cdot 1.25 \mathrm{~m}$ quilt wadding
- 1.25 m of quilt backing (or if using 112 cm fabric, you will need 21.25 m lengths joined at the selvedge)
- 5 m Quilt binding
- Prima 1/4inch Ruler
- Prima Square Quilting Ruler Clear 12.5 x 12.5
- Sewing supplies


## INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1 - Cut out 3, 8 "squares from each of your printed fabrics. You will need 36 squares in total

Step 2 - From the black prima cut the following

- $30 \times 1.5^{\prime \prime} \times 6.5^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
- $5 \times 1.5^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips
- $2 \times 2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 42$ " strips
- $2 \times 2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 46^{\prime \prime}$ strips (you will need to cut these strips WOF and then create a join in the strip to extend the length to 46 ")

Step 3 - Pair up each of your squares with a different pattern and place right sides together. Using the Prima $1 / 4$ ruler, mark a line on one side of each pair of squares (you should have 18 pairs)

Step 4 - Sew $1 / 4$ inch each side of the drawn line. Cut on the line. Repeat for all remaining pairs. You should have 36 half square triangle units.
Step 5 - Repeat step 2 and 3, using your half square triangles

Step 6 - Trim your quarter square triangles to measure 6.5 " square.

Tip - Line up where the center of the triangle shapes meet with the $31 / 4$ mark on the diagonal of your prima square quilting ruler, cut two sides and then turn the square to repeat for the other side
Step 7 - Lay out your quarter square triangles 6 rows of 6 and move them around until you are pleased with the layout.
Step 8 - For each row, sew one of the 1.5" x 6.5 " rectangles between each block. Repeat this for all 6 rows. Press seams towards the black fabric.

Step 9 - Join each row using the 1.5 " $\times 42$ " prima strips. Press seams towards the black fabric.

Step 10 - Add the $22.5 \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ border strips to the left and right of the quilt, then add the last two remaining strips ( 46 " long) to the top and bottom.

Step 11 - Press your quilt top, sandwich and quilt as desired.
Step 12 - Trim the backing and wadding to be square with the quilt top, attach binding to the quilt.

Tip - Use your leftover Halloween fabrics to make into binding, Simply cut into 2.5 " strips and join together to make one long strip, your binding strip should be 5 m long.
