# FRANCHEVILLE

## HEXAGON WALL ART

### WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- 3 x 'Francheville' 12" hexagon canvases
- 2 x 'Francheville 6" hexagon canvases
- 'Jo Sonja' Paints in naphthol crimson, yellow green, rose pink, pacific blue & titanium white
- Large and small paint brushes
- Water jar to clean brushes
- Large workspace to layout canvases
- Pencil

### INSTRUCTIONS

**Step 1** - Lay out all the canvases in the order you would like them to be displayed.

**Step 2** - Use the pencil to plan out your design on a piece of paper. Once you are happy with the final design use the pencil to lightly draw it onto the canvases. Plan out which colours will make up each section and form a list of layers for each colour starting from the bottom to the top for each canvas. This will help ensure you are working in the right order when it comes to painting.

**Step 3** - Begin painting on your canvases starting with which ever colour will be the bottom layer of your design on each canvas. Fill in the larger parts of your design with the large paint brush and use the smaller brush for the finer details and outlines. Allow paint to dry before painting the next colour layer.

**Step 4** - Continue this process of painting one layer at a time across each canvas until all your design has been painted.

**Step 5** -Once all the paint is dry you can paint extra fun bits on top of your design to add some interest. Allow all paint to dry before hanging.
