

## KUNG FU WALL HANGING



## INTERMEDIATE

## WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- 'Abbey Road' Kung Fu Cotton 100am, 2 balls main colour (M1) and contrast colour (C1)
- 5.5mm crochet hook
- · Rod for hanging
- · Scissors, yarn needle, tape measure

## **INSTRUCTIONS**

With M1, make a magic ring.

Round 1 - Ch3, (counts as 1 tr), tr 11 into ring. Join 3rd ch of starting ch with a sl st....12sts.

Round 2 - Ch3. (counts as 1 tr), tr into same st, 2 tr into each st, sl st into 3rd ch of starting ch....24 sts.

Round 3 - Ch3, (counts as 1 tr), tr into same st, 1 tr into next st, \*2tr in next st, 1tr into next st, rep from \* to end st, sl st into 3rd ch of starting ch....36 sts.

Round 4 - Ch3. (counts as 1 tr), tr into same st, ch1 2tr in next st, 1 htr into next 2 sts, 1dc in next 3 sts, 1htr in next 2 sts, \*2tr into same st, ch1, 2tr in next st, 1 htr into next 2 sts, 1dc in next 3 sts. 1htr in next 2 sts. rep from \* twice. Join 3rd ch of starting ch with a sl st and sl st to next corner 1ch sp.

Round 5 - Ch3, (counts as 1 tr), 1tr, 1ch, 2tr in corner sp, 1tr in each st until next corner, \*2tr, 1ch, 2tr into same sp, 1tr in each st until next corner, rep from \* twice. SI, st into 3rd ch of starting ch.

Round 6 - Ch1, dc in every st. At corners work 1dc, 1ch, 1dc and continue to end, sl st into starting ch and fasten off.

Make 2 squares in M1 and 1 in C.

Make 2 squares in M1 Round 1, the rest in C1, 1 square in C1 Round 1, the rest in M1.

Make 2 squares in M1 Round 1 and 2, the rest in C1, 1 square in C1 Round 1 and 2, the rest in M1.

Make 2 squares in M1 Round 1,2 and 3, the rest in C1, 1 square in C1 Round 1, 2 and 3, the rest in M1.

Arrange the squares as pictured and work the vertical seams first, joining with a dc using C1 into every stitch with wrong sides together. Once completed, work the vertical sides in the same manner.

Dc around all outer edges and in each corner work 1dc, 2ch, 1dc. Fasten off.

To make loops ch5, miss one chain and dc back to the end. Working on these 4 sts, dc until the loop measures approx 10cm. Make 2 in M1, 1 in C1 and sew to the top of the hanging as pictured. Thread a rod through and hang on the wall
