# LIA GRIFFITH

## CREPE PAPER FLOWERS

**e** EASY

### WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- Lia Griffith Crepe paper packs
- Fiskas Lia Griffith scissors
- Hot Glue gun and glue sticks
- Leaf template

### INSTRUCTIONS:

**Step 1** – Cut strips of crepe paper to roughly 20cm long

**Step 2** – Fold in half and stretch the crepe paper only along the folded edge, this will create the curled edge of the petals.

**Step 3** – Turn hot glue gun on.

**Step 4** – Begin to wrap the strip around itself and glue in place as you go.

**Step 5** – Continue steps 1-5 adding more strips until you have the size flower you want.

**Step 6** – Cut a small circle of felt and glue to the base to finish!

**Step 7** – To create leaves, cut leaf template out of crepe paper.

**Step 8** – Stretch the top of the leaf shape to create a slightly wavy edge.

**Step 9** – Twist the base of the leaves to create the stem.

**Step 10** – Glue onto base of flower to finish.
