## RIVER ROMP QUILT

## EASY

## WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- 1 panel River Romp 24 inch Panel - Teal (A) 871P-76
- $21 / 8$ yards ( 1.95 m ) Underwater Otters - Teal (B) 876-77
- 5/8 yard (0.58m) Lily Pads Allover - Green (C) 862-66
- 5/8 yard (0.58m) Bees and Blooms - Light Blue (D) 866-11
- $1 / 4$ yard ( 0.23 m ) Ducks in the Meadow Green (E) 864-66
- $13 / 4$ yards ( 1.60 m ) River Romp Stripe - Teal (F) 870-76
- $41 / 2$ yards ( $4.12 m$ ) Otters and Lily Pads - Teal (Backing) 861-76
*Includes binding


## FINISHED QUILT SIZE

44 " $\times 64$ " ( $111.76 \mathrm{~cm} \times 162.56 \mathrm{~cm}$ )

## INSTRUCTIONS

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.
From the River Romp 24 Inch Panel (Teal A):

- Fussy cut (1) $221 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 421 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle, centered on the panel.
From the Underwater Otters (Teal B) cut:
- (7) $21 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips for the binding.
-(2) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 421 / 2$ " Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- (2) $21 / 2$ " $\times 551 / 2$ " LOF strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut:
- (2) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 26 \frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
-(2) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 381 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips, piece as needed.
From the Lily Pads Allover (Green C), cut: - (3) $51 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) $51 / 2$ " squares.
From the Bees and Blooms (Light Blue D): - Fussy cut (3) $51 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) $51 / 2$ " squares.

From the Ducks in the Meadow (Green E): cut:

- (1) 7" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 7" squares.

From the River Romp Stripe (Teal F) cut:
-(2) 7 " $\times 58$ 1/2" LOF strips.

- (2) 7 " $\times 381 / 2$ " LOF strips.


## From the Otter and Lily Pads (Teal Backing)

 cut:- (2) 79" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to $59^{\prime \prime} \times 79^{\prime \prime}$ to make the back.


## BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 421 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B strip to each side of the $221 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 421_{2}^{\prime \prime \prime}$ Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) $21 / 2$ " $\times 26 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure $251 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 451 / 22^{\prime \prime}$.
2. Sew together (5) $51 / 2$ " Fabric $D$ squares and (4) $51 / 2$ " Fabric C squares, alternating them from top to bottom, to make (1) Side Border (Fig. 2). Repeat to make a second Side Border.

3. Sew together (4) $51 / 2$ " Fabric $C$ squares and (3) $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $D$ squares, alternating them from left to right, to make the Top Border (Fig. 3). Repeat to make the Bottom Border.

## QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
4. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block.
5. Sew the Top Border and the Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
6. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 55 \frac{112 "}{}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" $\times 381 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
7. Sew (1) 7 " $\times 581 / 2$ " Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block.
8. Sew (1) 7" Fabric E square to each end of (1) 7 " $\times 381 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) newly sewn strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
9. Layer and quilt as desired.
10. Sew the (7) $21 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
11. Bind as desired
