As a supplier of toys you must complete this form and return it to us along with test reports and photos as required to verify the products supplied meet the requirements of Australia's and New Zealand's applicable mandatory safety standards and bans for toys. These products will not be accepted by us or offered for sale until you have provided this verification.

It is illegal to supply toys in Australia or New Zealand if they do not comply with applicable mandatory safety standards and bans.

By completing this form you verify that products identified in this form comply with all the applicable mandatory standards and bans for toys.

Some of the mandatory safety standards that apply to toys include:

- **Small parts in toys (up to 3 years)** – Australia: Consumer Protection Notice No. 14 of 2003 as amended by Consumer Protection No. 1 of 2005; New Zealand: Product Safety Standards (Children's Toys) Regulations 2005 – **refer Annexure A**
- **Migration of elements (up to 6 years)** – Australia: Consumer Protection Notice No. 1 of 2009; New Zealand: Unsafe Goods (Lead in Children's Toys) Notice 2009 – **refer Annexure B**

## Annexure A - Toys for Children Up to 3 years

**As a supplier of “toys for children up to 3 years” you must complete this Annexure to verify the products to be supplied meet the requirements of Australia’s and New Zealand’s mandatory standard for toys for children up to 3 years.**

By completing this Annexure you are verifying the products comply with the mandatory standard for toys for children up to 3 years.

**What products must comply? Toys for children up to and including 36 months old being objects manufactured, designed, labelled or marketed as playthings.** Some examples include: rattles, toy dummies, teethingers; squeeze toys; toys to be attached to a crib, stroller, playpen or baby carriage; pull and push toys; pounding toys; blocks; stacking toys; toys for use in a bath tub; rocking, spring and stick horses and figures; musical chime toys; jacks-in-the-box; stuffed, plush and flocked animals and figures; toys with pompoms games; puzzles; dolls; toy cars, trucks and other vehicles.

**NOTE:** Even if toys are labelled and/or marketed for older children, the mandatory standard may apply if the toys are commonly recognised as being intended or suitable for children under 36 months of age. Some guidance on appropriate ages for using toys can be found in: Annex B of AS/NZS ISO 8124.1:2002 Safety of toys; and United States age determination guidelines by the US Consumer Product Safety Commission.

**What products must comply?** A toy designed to bear the mass of a child under the age of 14 for use in play in shallow water (whether or not it is inflatable and whether or not it is designed to be worn or otherwise attached to the body).

**INCLUDING** but not limited to:

- inflatable novelty shapes;
- inflatable toy boats intended for use in shallow water;
- unattached complete or partial rings.

**NOT including:**

- beach balls, surfboards, body boards or kick boards;
- inflatable boats intended for use in deep water;
- inflatable air beds.

## Annexure E – Toys Containing Hazardous Magnets

**As a supplier of “toys containing magnets” you must complete this Annexure and return it to us to verify the products to be supplied meet the requirements of Australia’s mandatory standard for toys containing hazardous magnets.**

By completing this Annexure you are verifying the products comply with the mandatory standard for toys containing hazardous magnets.

**What products must comply?** All toys for children under 14 years that contain a “**hazardous magnet**” which is a magnet with a magnetic strength or flux index more than 50 kG<sup>2</sup> mm<sup>2</sup> and comes in any of the following shapes and sizes or fits within any of the following:

- a cylinder with a length of 32 mm or less and a diameter of 11 mm or less;
- a disc with a diameter of 26 mm or less and a thickness of 5 mm or less;
- a sphere with a diameter of 22 mm or less.

**What products do not have to comply?** Sporting goods, camping goods, bicycles, home and public playground equipment, trampolines, electronic game units, models powered by combustion or steam engines, and fashion jewellery.

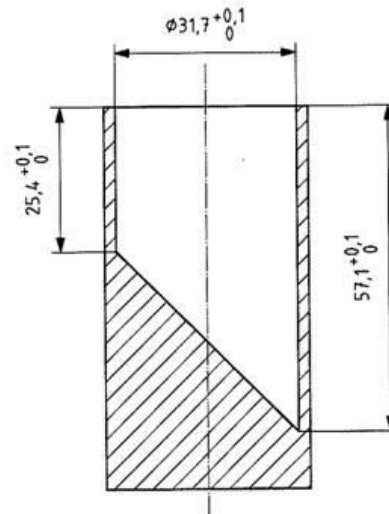
By completing this Annexure you are verifying the products are not small, high powered magnets.

**What products are banned? Small high powered magnets”** are banned are must not be supplied.

**What are “Small high powered magnets”?** Separable or loose magnetic objects that are supplied in **multiples of two or more** for personal, domestic or household use where:

- (a) at least two of those magnetic objects are each separately able to fit entirely, in any orientation, into the small parts cylinder (see below);
- (b) at least two of those magnetic objects each separately have a magnetic flux index greater than 50 (kG)2 mm2 ; and
- (c) the magnetic objects are marketed by the supplier as, or supplied for use as:
  - a toy, game or puzzle (including an adult desk toy, an educational toy or game, a toy, game or puzzle for mental stimulation or stress relief); or
  - a construction or modelling kit; or
  - jewellery to be worn in or around the mouth or nose.
