

# WINTER PETALS BABY COCOON

INTERMEDIATE

## WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- Passioknit Peketa Yarn :-
  - 2 x 100g balls 1st Colour (C1)
  - 2 x 100g balls 2nd Colour (C2)
- A pair 6.50mm (US 10½), (UK 3) Knitting Needles or size that gives correct tension/gauge.
- A Yarn Needle.

## MEASUREMENTS

Width (approx) 40 cms/16 ins

Total length (including hood) 95 cms/37 ins

## TENSION/GAUGE

10 sts to 10 cms/4 ins in width over garter st, using 6.50mm (US 10½), (UK 3) Knitting Needles.

**Note** - Correct tension/gauge is essential for a successful handknit.



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## ABBREVIATIONS

**St/s** - stitch/es, **K** - Knit, **RS** - right side, **WS** - wrong side, garter st - every row knit, **beg** - begin/ning, **cont** - continue, **rep** - repeat.

## CREATE

### Cocoon

Using 6.50mm (US 10½), (UK 3) Needles and **C1**, cast on 40 sts loosely.

Using **C1**, knit in garter st (1st row is RS) until work measures 15 cms/6 ins from beg, working last row on WS. Break off **C1**.

Using **C2**, cont in garter st for 10 cms/4 ins, working last row on WS. Break off **C2**.

Using **C1**, cont in garter st for 10 cms/4 ins, working last row on WS. Break off **C1**.

Using **C2**, cont in garter st for 20 cms/8 ins, working last row on WS. Break off **C2**.

Using **C1**, cont in garter st for 10 cms/4 ins, working last row on WS. Break off **C1**.

Using **C2**, cont in garter st for 10 cms/4 ins, working last row on WS. Break off **C2**.

Tie a coloured thread at each end of last row for sewing up purposes.

\*\* Using **C1**, cont in garter st for 5 cms/2 ins, working last row on WS. Break off **C1**.

Using **C2**, cont in garter st for 5 cms/2 ins, working last row on WS. Break off **C2**. \*\*

Rep from \*\* to \*\* once more.

Cast off loosely knitways.

## FINISHING

DO NOT PRESS. Using yarn needle, darn in ends.

Fold cast on edge under to WS for 5 cms/2 ins to form a cuff and using mattress st, join side seams. With RS facing, fold lower edge up to where the coloured threads were tied and join side seams, matching stripes. Fold cast off edge in half so that each end meets and using a flat seam, join to form top of hood.
